For security and safety, you need to review the videos given by the University Police. These videos provide information and training for how to handle different dangerous situations that possibly could happen.

1. The main one we want you to watch is "Shots Fired" which can be found using this link: [BYU Shots Fired Video](#). If it doesn't open in your normal internet browser and instructs you to download the latest Adobe Flashplayer, we recommend that you switch to a different browser. We found that we couldn't get it to work on Chrome or Internet Explorer, but it did work on Mozilla. Use the link for the school version. The page should look like this:
